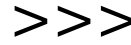

These efforts are not recent, nor are they politically motivated. They are the continuation of a long-standing dedication to community development - one that began long before any declaration of political ambition.

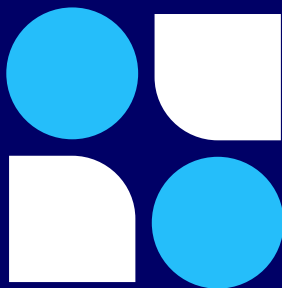
The Abbas Saraki Support Organisation (ASSO) Bulletin

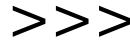

leadership that prioritizes people first - investing in their growth, supporting their livelihoods, and building systems that enable long-term development.

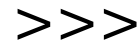

FEATURE STORY (EDUCATION PROJECTS)

**Investing In Education, Empowering The Future**

Education remains one of the most powerful tools for societal transformation.

Recognizing this, Hon. Abbas Uba Saraki, through the IMKASH Charitable Foundation, has continued to

invest in educational infrastructure and learning environments across communities.

These interventions are not isolated efforts. They are part

of a broader vision to ensure that every child has access to quality education in a conducive and well-structured environment.

1. Upgrading Learning Facilities at Kachako Government Secondary School

At Kachako Government Secondary School, four classrooms were renovated and upgraded, significantly enhancing the learning environment for students. These improvements have created more structured, conducive, and comfortable spaces that support effective teaching and learning.

As part of this effort, a total of 120 student desks were provided, with 30 desks allocated to each of the four upgraded classrooms. This ensures that students have proper seating arrangements that support comfort and concentration during lessons.

Students now benefit from classrooms that are better

organized and more suitable for academic engagement, contributing to improved focus and overall learning outcomes.

These interventions reflect a clear understanding that education is not only about access, but also about the quality of infrastructure.



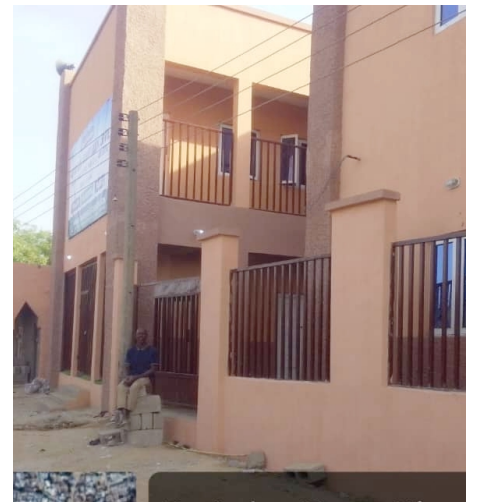


2. Integrated School Development in Kachako

In Kachako, his hometown, Hon. Abbas Uba Saraki supported the construction of another integrated school combining Primary, Islamiyya, and Tahfiz education.

This project reflects not only a commitment to development but also a deep connection to community roots and identity.

The school provides a conducive environment where young learners can grow academically and spiritually, reinforcing values that shape responsible individuals and future leaders, while promoting balanced learning.



3. Integrated School Development in Mariri, Kano

Through the IMKASH Charitable Foundation, Hon. Abbas Uba Saraki supported the construction of an integrated learning centre in Mariri, Kano.

The project brings together Primary, Islamiyya, and Tahfiz education in one location, creating a system that supports both academic learning and moral

development. This integrated model ensures that children do not have to choose between formal education and religious learning. Instead, they benefit from a balanced system that nurtures knowledge, discipline, and character.

The facility includes:

1. Well-equipped classrooms

2. Learning furniture and materials
3. Administrative and staff areas
4. Sanitary facilities
5. A structured learning environment designed for long-term use

This initiative stands as a testament to the belief that education must be both holistic and accessible.

Sustainable development cannot be achieved in isolation, it requires unity, participation, and a common vision for a better tomorrow.

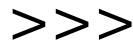
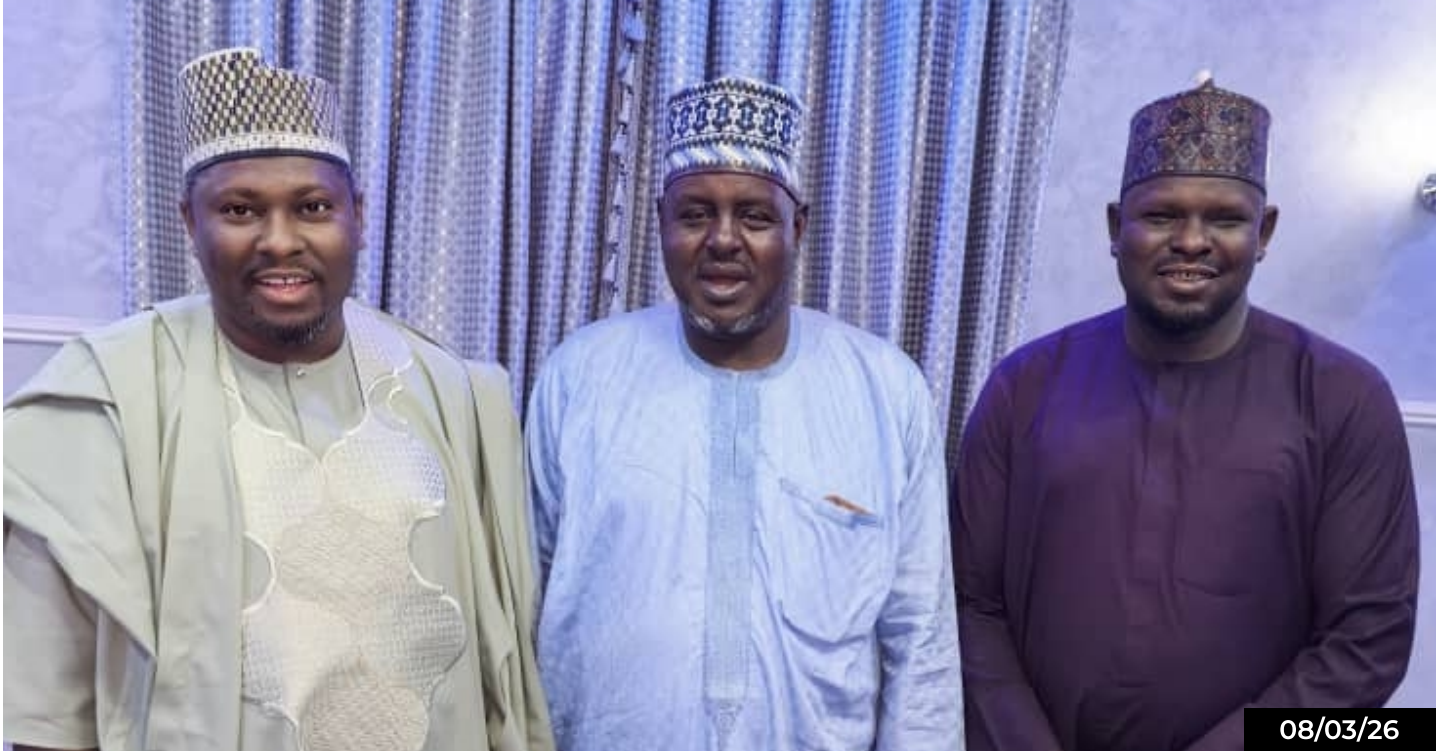
7. A Vision Driven by Service

4. Visit to Hon. Abduljabbar Umar – Commissioner for Land & Physical Planning



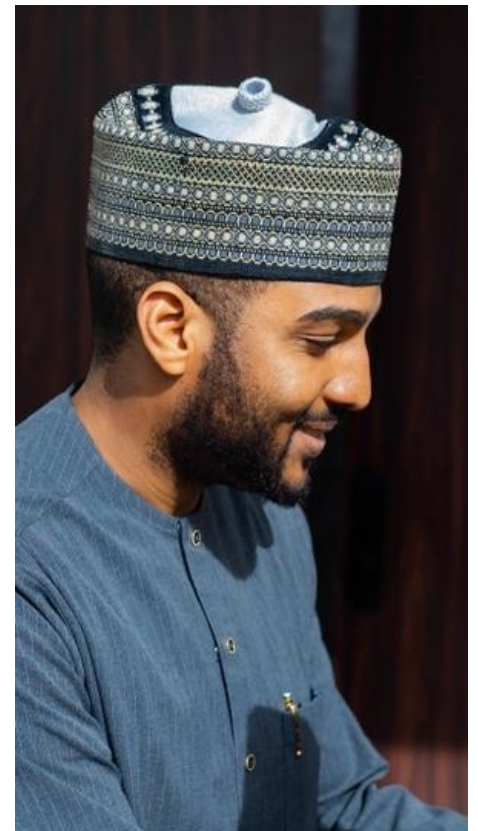
On 10th March 2026, Hon. Abbas Uba Saraki paid a courtesy visit to Hon. Abduljabbar Umar.

7. Meeting with Former Councilors (2021–2024)



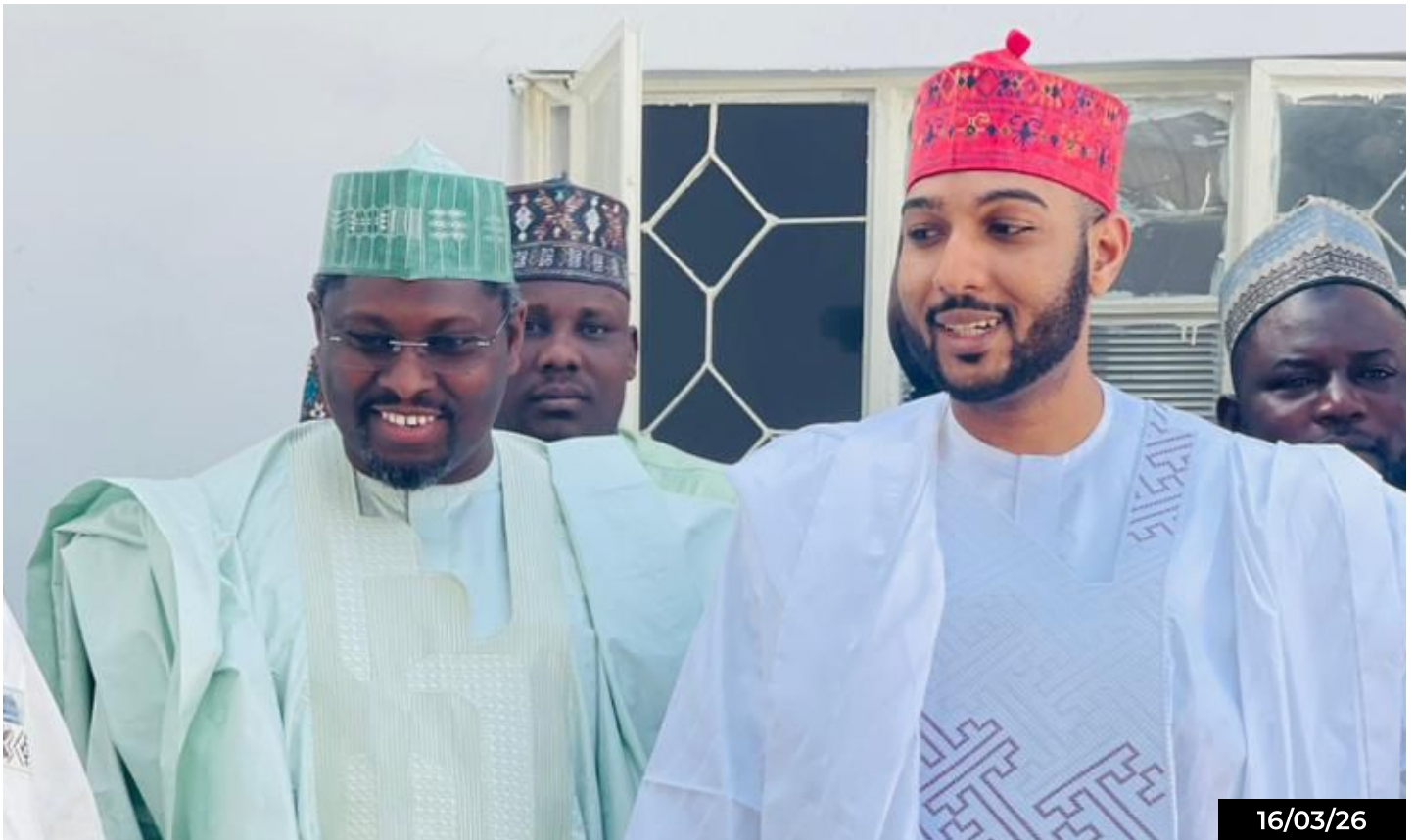
Also on 15th March, Hon. Abbas Uba Saraki held a meeting with former Councilors who served between 2021 and 2024.

9. Eid al-Fitr Visit to Gaya Emirate



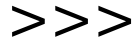
On 20th March 2026, Hon. Abbas Uba Saraki joined a delegation of the Kano State Government on a Sallah homage to the Gaya Emirate.
