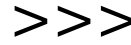

but to strengthen relationships, build trust, and align efforts towards a common goal.

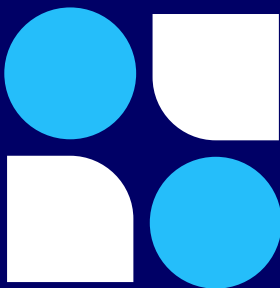

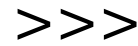
citizens. Each interaction contributed to strengthening unity and building a more coordinated structure within the constituency.

FEATURE STORY (COMMUNITY IMPACT)

**Restoring Access to Clean Water and Improving Everyday Life**

Access to clean water remains one of the most essential elements of community well-being. It directly affects health, productivity, and the overall quality of life. When access is limited or disrupted, the burden falls heavily on households, particularly women and children.

On the 5th of April 2026, Hon. Abbas Uba Saraki, in collaboration with SIMO Group, facilitated the repair of two manual borehole hand pumps in Diribo, Karfi Ward, within Takai Local Government Area.

Before this intervention, residents faced daily challenges in accessing safe

and reliable water. The repair of these boreholes has significantly eased that burden, restoring a dependable source of clean water to the community.

The impact of this intervention goes beyond the physical repair of infrastructure. It represents a direct response to a real need within the community. It reflects a leadership approach that prioritizes practical solutions and immediate impact.

Community members expressed their appreciation in simple but powerful words. ***Ruwa shi ne rayuwa.*** *Water is life.* These words capture

the true significance of the intervention and the difference it has made in the lives of the people.

Expressions of gratitude such as ***Allah Ya saka da alheri*** further highlight the connection between leadership and the people. When leadership responds to real needs, it builds trust and reinforces confidence.

This initiative serves as a reminder that meaningful development begins with addressing the fundamentals. By focusing on essential needs, a strong foundation is created for broader progress and long-term improvement.

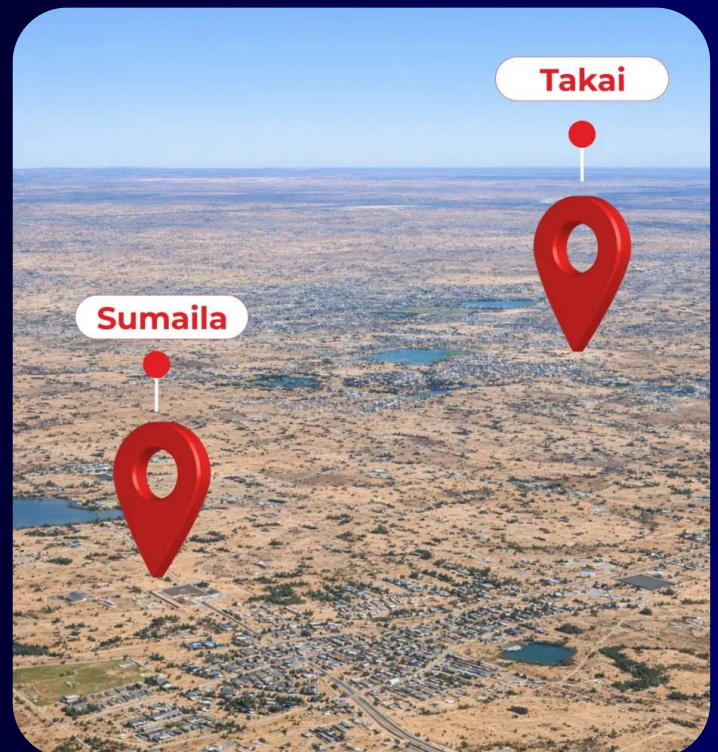
A practical and people-centered approach to strengthening communities, expanding opportunities, and improving the quality of life across Sumaila and Takai Federal Constituency.

3. Special Visit to Hon. Sani Adamu Zuga

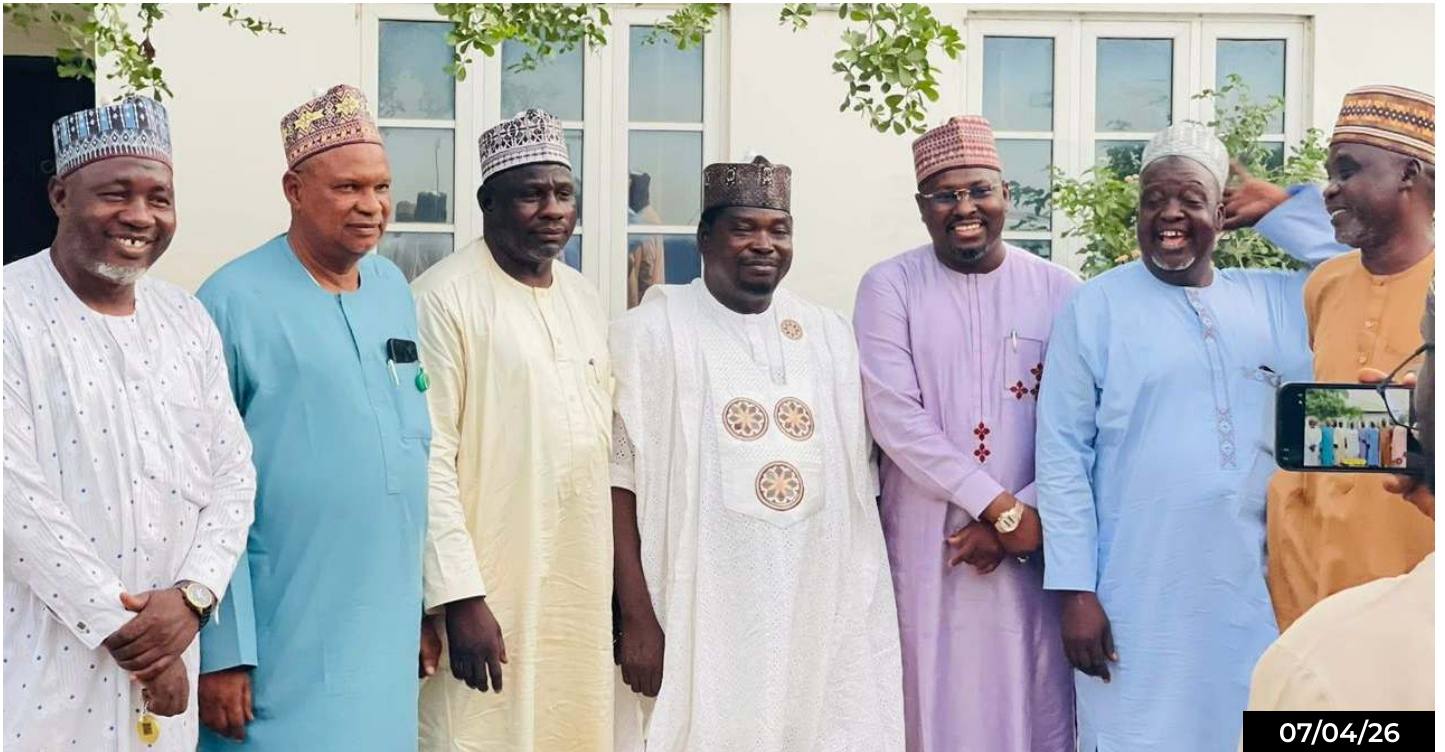

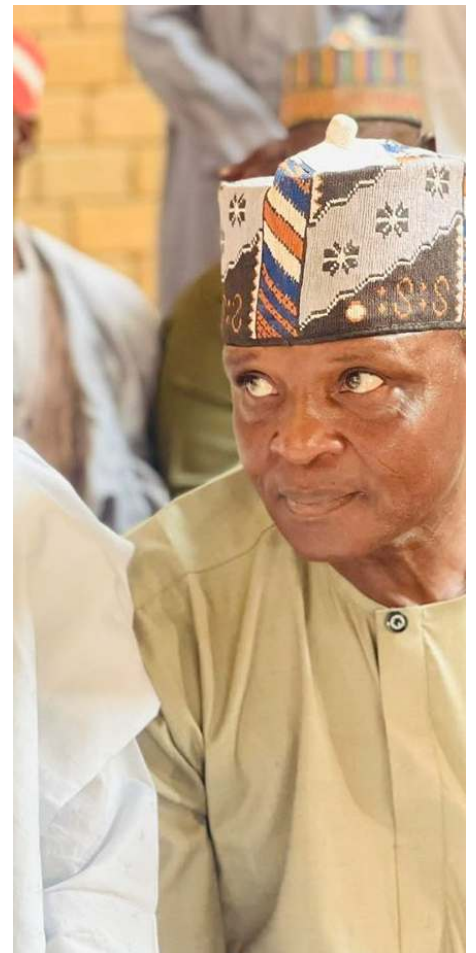


5. Strategic Engagement with Ward Executives Across Eleven Wards

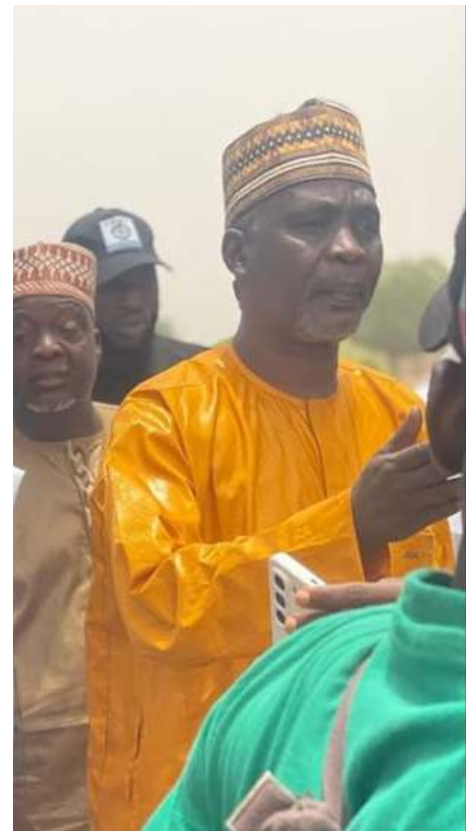


6. Engagement with Former Caretaker Ward Councillors

The engagement provided an opportunity for reflection and alignment on the path forward. Members expressed confidence in the shared vision and reaffirmed their commitment to unity and progress.

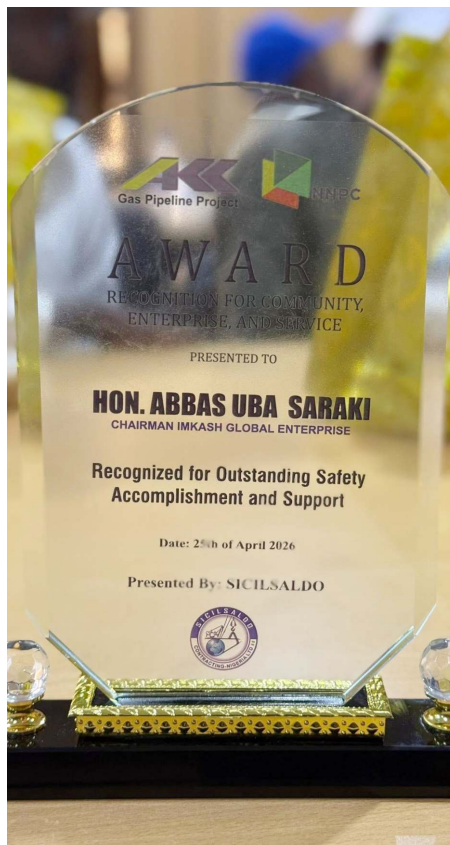


8. Recognition for Safety and Community Impact

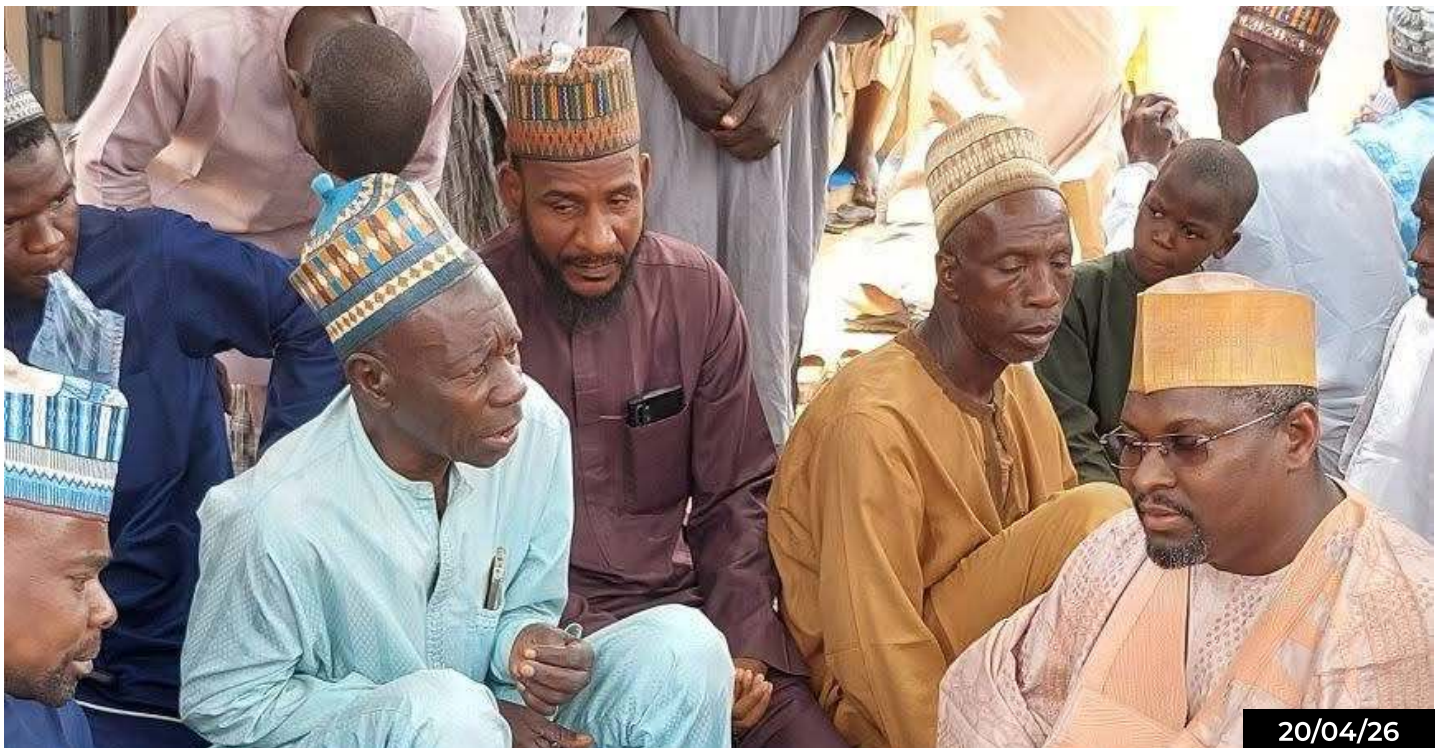
